For the purpose of this declaration, a person has a gambling problem if the person can't manage properly the person's gambling activities. Examples of signs that a person has a gambling problem include:

- A. Admitting being unable to stop gambling or to gamble within the person's means.
- B. Expressing concern about the amount of time or money the person spends on gambling.
- C. Acknowledging the person spends on gambling money needed for day-to-day living expenses, including for dependants.
- D. Having a disagreement with a family member or friend about the person's gambling behaviour.
